Applications received after midnight on March 7, 2018 are not eligible for awards of any kind.

Process Timeline:

December 1, 2017	Dues must be paid by your school and received by PIN by Dec. 1st in order to be eligible for a Community Service Award.
March 7, 2018	Community Service Applications must be emailed by midnight to the Community Service Coordinator for your division.
April TBD	Applications will be reviewed by the decision committee
April 25, 2018	Awards will be presented at the final PIN meeting, hosted by Charles River School, Dover, MA
