

# 2023-2024 PIN COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD APPLICATION PREP DOC

This document is intended to help applicants prepare their content/answers offline, prior to submitting answers in the google form online. It is intended also to aid application preparation when there are multiple collaborators that may like to contribute to the writing of responses.

Please read these guidelines carefully BEFORE beginning your application.

## AWARD ELIGIBILITY & PIN SCHOOL DUES:

Only member schools that have paid their annual dues (\$125) by the December 1, 2023 deadline are eligible for consideration for recognition and/or financial grant awards. PIN dues directly fund the PIN grant awards and PIN expenses, therefore schools that have not paid dues are unable to be considered. Please confirm dues have been paid on our website <https://pin-inc.org/dues/> (login required).

## DUE DATE:

APRIL 3, 2024 - Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

## APPLICATION:

You will NOT be able to continue to edit your application in the Google Form once you have submitted it.  
Please have all your information for the application questions ready before you begin the application.

This application is for projects completed between March 31, 2023 and March 31, 2024. If your school completed more than one service project, please submit a separate google form for each.

## TIMELINE:

December 1, 2023 ... School Dues must be paid by this deadline in order for service projects to be considered.

April 3, 2024 ... Application Due Date

Late April 2024 ... Award Notification – via email

May 7, 2024 at 12pm... Community Service Award Event via Zoom

## AWARD TYPES ... PIN offers two award categories:

- Special Recognition | Acknowledgement of a service project. ALL projects are considered for Special Recognition. Recipients receive an award certificate.
- Grant Awards | Monetary funding up to \$500 per project. Projects may request consideration for a grant award in addition to a recognition certificate. Grant awards may be used to support the financial costs of a project, subject to limitations (see application page 4 for details).

- Grant checks are awarded to the recognized member school, not individuals, and mailed directly to the school's CFO at the business office.
